

Call for Papers:

The CUE SIG is pleased to announce a call for papers from presenters at the 2025 joint CUE SIG Conference with BizCom SIG and Peace as a Global Language (PGL) at Hitotsubashi University. The submissions are for the *OnCUE Journal Special Conference Issue*, Vol. 7 (proceedings). The expected date of publication is Summer/Fall 2026.

All submissions will be subject to a peer review process. Members and nonmembers of the 3 host groups may submit.

Articles to be considered from the conference:

- **Research Paper from Slideshow or Poster Presentation:**

2,500-3,000 words excluding title, abstract, references, and appendices.

This should be submitted with IMRaD (Introduction, Methods, Results, and Discussion) format.

- **Practice-Oriented Paper from Slideshow or Poster Presentation:**

1,000-2,000 words excluding title, abstract, references, and appendices.

These are not research based, so the format is more casual (no IMRaD needed). Authors should not overdo the number of headings and subheadings, though.

Language for submissions:

Papers should be submitted in English or Japanese. All authors are strongly advised to have their articles proofread by a trusted colleague before submission. Abstracts in English are required for all papers, but authors may provide abstracts in both English and Japanese.

Abstract and Author's Bio:

Papers must have an abstract (150-200 words), and an author bio (50 words maximum including contact email as the last word).

Format:

Upload Microsoft Word only. Submissions should be prepared according to the American Psychological Association (APA) Publication Manual, 7th Ed. For general information regarding guidelines, refer to the CUE author template (<http://jaltcue.org/content/submitting-guidelines>). Manuscripts that do not conform to these formatting guidelines will not be accepted. You may submit with whatever choice of font types that you prefer, but use a large font size.

Notes: Do not use “running heads” in your document. Figures should be inserted into the manuscript and submitted separately in color or black and white JPG format (provide captions separately at the end of the manuscript). Do not include the figure title as part of the figure itself but as separate text in the Word file. Tables should be created using MS Word and inserted approximately where they are expected to appear in the paper.
